"The goal of this travel journey is to capture the heart of the Emerald Isle. From north to south, from the depth of its history, to the mystical connections of its spirituality."





**Day 1** Make your way to the outskirts of Belfast to the Old Inn in the town of Crawfordsburn. This historic inn was C.S. Lewis's favourite retreat. The forest walks behind the property were the inspiration for his Chronicles of Narnia series. Our first evening will be our official meet and greet.

**Day 2** will be free for you to explore the area surrounding the Old Inn. Enjoy the amenities of the Inn of take in the numerous walks that lead down to Belfast Lough through the "Narnia" forest.

**Day 3** We leave Crawfordsburn and head into Belfast, checking in at the iconic Titanic Hotel. In the morning we visit the Titanic museum. In the afternoon we will do a guided walk around the Cathedral District of Belfast where we will hear stories of the city and its history.

**Day 4** From Belfast we will head south on the train to Dublin. Our first stop will be at the EPIC Irish Immigration Museum, where we will be free to explore the museum. In the afternoon we will be led on a walking tour of Dublin, focusing on the mythology and folklore of the town.

**Day 5** Today will be spent at Trinity College, with a tour of the facility, the old library and entrance to the Book of Kells exhibit. The afternoon will be free for you to explore the city.

**Day 6** We head by bus to Glendalough, the site of a monastic community over 1400 years old. We will settle into our hotel and then head to the Glendalough information centre where we will be given a tour of the monastic site.

**Day 7** Today is yours to shape as you please. Make your way down to the upper lake, or to the remains of Reefert church, nestled in the hills overlooking the upper lake. You wil be provided with a map of the walks that can be taken in the area.

**Day 8** Today we say farewell. Check out of the hotel and catch the bus to Dublin where we will part ways. Let us know and we can help you make arrangements to get you to your next stop.

**Day 7** We leave York and take the train to Norwich, the capital of East Anglia, the last of the four kingdoms. In the afternoon Rob will take you on a walking tour of this unique town.

**Day 8** Today we say farewell. Check out of the hotel and take the train to London where we will part ways. Let us know and we can help you make arrangements to get you to your next stop.



Day 1 We meet in Granada and check in to our hotel. Our first evening will be our official meet and greet. That evening we will meet with Fede, who will take us on a walking tour of Albayzín and Sacromonte.

Day 2 Today we head up to the Unesco World Heritage site of the Alhambra, where we will spend the morning visiting the palace and fortress complex. In the afternoon we will head to the Granada Cathedral leaving us free time in the evening to wonder the streets of Granada.

Day 3 We leave Granada and head to Antequera, known as the crossroads of Andalucia. You have the option to hike to the famous Dolmens, unique to this area (additional cost, must be booked in advance), or let Rob take you through the streets of this beautiful town.

Day 4 We make our way by train to Cordoba, the ancient Roman city and Moorish Capital in the Middle Ages. We will walk the streets of a city that holds over 2,000 years of history. In the evening we will enjoy Oil Tasting with Mari Carmen - whose family have run an Olive Tree farm for generations.

Day 5 Today we head to the Unesco World Heritage site of the Mosque Cathedral of Cordoba and spend the morning unpacking the rich history of Cordoba. In the afternoon we will spend time in the Patio de los Naranjos (Courtyard of the Oranges Trees). The Orange trees have been growing here for 1500 years.

Day 6 From Cordoba we hop back on the train and head to the majestic city of Seville, capital of Andalusia. In the afternoon we will cross the river walk the streets of the Triana district.

Day 7 In the morning we head to the centre of town. Lovely walks along wide, tree-lined streets, we visit the Cathedral of Seville, the Plaza de España and other sites surrounding the ancient Roman city originally called Hispalis.

Day 8 Today we say farewell. Let us know and we can help you make arrangements to get you to your next stop.

**Day 1** We meet in Barcelona and check in to our hotel. Our first evening will be our official meet and greet.

**Day 2** This morning is full as we join a tour of the Sagrada Familia and Park Güell, two of Antoni Gaudí's modernist masterpieces. The afternoon is free for you to explore.

**Day 3** Today we leave Barcelona and make a pilgrimage to the mystical mountaintop retreat of Montserrat. We will explore this nearly 1,000-year-old Benedictine Monastery complex set high above Catalonia.

Day 4 We again leave Barcelona and head up the coast to Tarragona, and walk in the footsteps of gladiators and merchants at the UNESCO-listed ancient Roman ruins, and then explore the bohemian vibe and Modernist architecture of Sitges as we tour the old town.

**Day 5** Today is yours to make. Enjoy all that Barcelona has to offer. Speak with our tour guide, Rob, if you want any ideas. This evening we will join Alessio as he takes us on an enchanting walk through Barcelona's Gothic district, where we will see and hear history come to life.

We will go through the Catalonian villages of northeastern Spain and take a guided tour of towns of Pals and Calella de Palafrugell. Along the way we will take in the breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea.



**Day 1** We meet in Ancient Greek capital city of Athens. Our first evening will be our official meet and greet. This evening we will walk the streets where Rob will give you an overview of the history of this great city.

**Day 2** We head up to the Acropolis where we will skip the lines and be taken on a private tour. We will discover the myths behind the Acropolis, the Temple of Zeus, the Ancient Agora, and more.

**Day 3** Today we leave Athens and head to Delphi. We will travel back in time as we explore and learn about the Temple of Apollo, Thermopylae, and more, then stroll around the charming village of Arachova.

**Day 4** Today we explore the ruins of ancient Corinth and see the Corinth Canal. Rob will unpack the history of this ancient site, and the impact it has had on Christianity. After Corinth we visit the seaside town of Kehreai before making our way back to Athens.

**Day 5** Today is a free day and yours to make. Rob will be happy to help with ideas and recommendations. He will even join you if that is your wish. There is a lot to see and do around Athens, from Marathon Beach to the Temple of Poseidon, from a day cruise to the island of Hydra to a day trip to Mycenae.

**Day 6** Today we take an early morning flight to the island of Crete and city of Heraklion. We check into our hotel and then Rob will take you on a walk around the ancient port and explore its history and archaeology.

We will then visit the Lasithi plateau before heading to the Historical Site of Knossos, the major centre of the ancient Minoan civilisation. Rob will take you on a guided tour of this Bronze Age archaeological site.



June 3 Make your way to the hotel in Rome. Afternoon meet and greet, and overview of what's to come. We'll take the time today to get acquainted and prepare for the coming days. Later that evening will have a night walking tour around some of the sites of the eternal city.

June 4 This morning we begin by heading to the Colosseum. We will skip the lines and be given a full tour of the arena with an overview of the building and have access to areas not open to the public. From there we head across to the Forum, taking in the ancient site of the emperor's palace, the senate and market areas. We will head under Piazza Navona and see the remains of Domitian's Circus. It's all about imagery today as bring into focus the Book of Revelation.

June 5 Today we engage with the religion of Rome and how much of an impact it had on the development of Christianity and imagery of the Book of Revelation. We will visit the Pantheon, St Ignatius Church, we will go under St Clementine's church and explore the Roman cult of Mithras, and lastly, the Basilica of St John Lateran. The afternoon will be free for you to explore the city.

June 6 From Rome we will fly to Athens. While the Greek world was overshadowed by the Roman Empire, much of the underlying symbolism found in the book of Revelation has a strong Greek foundation. In the afternoon we will head up to the Acropolis, the Temple of Zeus and the Agora, where we be personally guided through the ancient sites. Later in the evening we will do a walking tour of the city.

This is a study intensive tour as we unpack together the Book of Revelation. It will involve a lot of walking, so please be prepared. There will be a number of talks each day at each of the sites visited, as part of the biblical study. While much of the tour is planned, there will be free time to explore other aspects of the areas we visit.

June 7 Today we spend the day in Delphi, exploring the impact this important site had on the ethos of the ancient world. Understanding the Book of Revelation means understanding the world in which those first readers of the letter were living in.

June 8 Today we take the ferry to the Island of Patmos where the author of the Book of Revelation, John, was exiled to, and from where he wrote the book. We will visit the church dedicated to St John. We spend the evening working through the study together.

June 9 We will visit the church dedicated to St John. We spend the evening working through the study together.

June 10 Today is a chill day. Sitting on the island where the book of Revelation was written gives us time to stop and just be. A free day to rest, relax, and an opportunity to talk and discuss.











June 11 We take the ferry across to Turkey and to Kuşadasi, our base from where we will access the ancient city of Ephesus, the primary recipients to which the Book of Revelation was written to.

June 12 Today we spend the day at the ancient site of Ephesus. While famous for it being the city to which John's Revelation was written to, it was also the city centred around a number of other biblical books. There's a lot to unpack here, and we will do it walking in the dust of history!

June 13 From Kuşadasi we head to İzmir, known in the Book of Revelation as Smyrna. Today we will explore this city and its ancient past.

June 14 Today is a travel day as we fly from İzmir to Istanbul. Depending on how we are all feeling, we will plan an evening walking tour of Istanbul.

June 15 Today we engage with the ancient Byzantine capital, from the Hagia Sofia to the Royal Palace, and its impact on the growth of the church in the Middle Ages. We end our tour with the final chapter of Book of Revelation in Istanbul.

Sep. 19 Today is a big day. First up is a tour of the 15th-century Rosslyn Chapel, famously featured in 'The Da Vinci Code' and renowned for its mysterious stone carvings and unique architecture. From there we head to Melrose Abbey, the burial site of King Robert the Bruce's heart, and look out over the English border from Cheviot Hills, before walking along the UNESCO-listed Hadrian's Wall stopping at Housesteads Fort in Northumberland National Park.

We journey from Scandinavia, thru Britain, to the shores of Normandy, where the North Men settled and shaped history as we know it today. This is a study tour on the history of the Early Middle Ages, and especially, the impact of Christianity in this period. It will involve a lot of walking, so please be prepared. While much of the tour is planned, there will be free time to explore other aspects of the areas we visit.

**Sep. 20** We leave Edinburgh and take the train to York. The afternoon is yours to explore this historically rich town.


